Dying With Dignity Canada (DWDC) is the national human-rights charity committed to improving quality of dying, protecting end-of-life rights, and helping people across Canada avoid unwanted suffering.
They defend human rights by advocating for assisted dying rules that respect the Canadian Constitution and the Charter of Rights and Freedoms

 They provide support to adults suffering from a grievous and irremediable medical condition who wish to die on their own terms
 They educate people across Canada about all their legal end-of-life options, including the constitutional right to medical assistance in dying (MAID), and the importance of Advance Care Planning

•They also provide support to health care practitioners who assess for and provide MAID. One of our family members works closely with this organization and a few months back offered us some free education regarding certain topics:

-Advanced Care Planning -End of Life -MAID
